Dear Parents of The Autism Clinic of Hope,

As I am sure you are aware, Governor Pritzker announced Friday that all Illinois schools will close as the result of the COVID-19 outbreak. To be socially responsible, The Autism Clinic at Hope is choosing to follow suit and close our Illinois clinics from Tuesday, March 17th through March 30th.

This decision did not come lightly as we know that the therapy we provide to your child is imperative to their learning and development. Our hope is that by taking action now, we will put into place preventative measures to ensure the safety and health of our students, families, and communities.

Our clinical team will be available during this closure and will reach out to you in the coming days. We are actively investigating providing ABA family consultations via telehealth and other measures to support you during this time. I will continue to provide you with any updates.
